## Sydney Observatory Excursion

Dear Parents and Carers,

To complement our Science and Mathematics units this term, Years 1 and 2 will be visiting the Sydney Observatory. We will be participating in a program called *Measuring the Weather*. Students will engage in authentic collection and interpretation of meteorological data using weather instruments, and learn about ways in which scientific data helps us in our daily lives.

**1E, 1H and 2S will visit the Sydney Observatory on Monday the 22 of October.**

**1B, 1J and 2A will visit the Sydney Observatory on Wednesday the 24 of October.**

**2N and 2P will visit the Sydney Observatory on Thursday the 25 of October.**

The cost of the excursion is included in the schools fees. If you are PAYG payment must be received prior to the excursion.

Children need to be at school (Kempbridge Campus) by 9:15am for roll call as the buses leave at 10:00am sharp. Students will be back at Kempbridge Campus before school finishing time.
