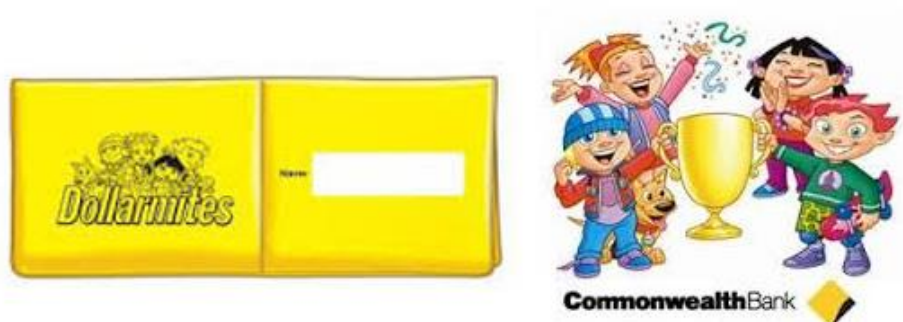
### And finally ...
