#### From the Deputy Principals Desk

Tracking attendance is an important requirement of the school by the Department of Education. It is also a means for us to account for all children in attendance on any given day and ensure their safety should we have a critical incident during the school day. This is of particular importance to Seaforth, being a split site with quite a distance between campuses.

To assist all our staff with tracking attendance I would ask that all parents follow the procedures we have in place regarding:

#### Arriving late to school and leaving early

At BOTH campuses, the process is the same. A child arriving late or leaving early must be accompanied by a parent or responsible adult to the school office. The adult must sign the Late Arrivals/Early Leavers Book at the office of the campus the child attends. The office staff will enter the time of arrival into our computer system and print a slip that

The parent/adult must accompany the child to the classroom and handover the computer generated slip to the teacher. This act transfers the duty of care from the adult to the school.

Please do not drop your child to school late without accompanying them to the office and following this procedure.

#### Absence from school

If your child is sick or not attending school for a justifiable reason you must provide a note to the class teacher explaining the absence on the first day of the child's return to school. Unexplained absences whether whole or part days that become considerable in number, become the business of the Home School Liaison Office who audits our school's attendance yearly.

Thank you in anticipation of following these procedures and keeping all our children safe.

#### **Upcoming Events:**


