New ACSIA Anaphylaxis and Asthma Plans

On Tuesday 2 August 2016, the Australasian Society of Clinical Immunology and Allergy (ASCI) published its updated 2016 Action Plans for Anaphylaxis and Allergic reactions.

The main changes to these plans are:

- an increased emphasis of key messages, with the inclusion of images to show how to position a person with anaphylaxis;
- revised wording regarding the importance of giving an adrenaline (epinephrine) auto-injector first, then asthma medication to a person with severe allergy and asthma; and
- the addition of the wording 'hold leg still' to the 'how to give EpiPen instructions'.

Over the course of the year, I ask that all parents at the time of their child's annual assessment or by the end of term 4 ensure that the school receives an updated ACSIA plan on the new action plan which is available for parents to download at:

For the school, it is a Work Place, Health and Safety Audit requirement that all students identified as requiring an autoimmune injector (epi-pen) provide the school with the latest 2016 updated action plan.

We need to finalise our enrolments shortly to the Department of Education so your assistance with this will be very much appreciated. Hi Families,

Term 3 is nearly over and Vacation Care is just around the corner. Copies of the program have been emailed and there are hard copies available at the Centre. Please return these as soon as possible to secure your booking!

If you haven't been receiving emails from the Centre, please let us know so we can update your email address. Email is our main form of communication with families. We send out regular surveys to improve our service, important updates, notices and procedures. Weekly Summaries and Newsletters are also communicated through email.

Our re-enrolment process for 2017 is slightly different to previous years. A new enrolment form is required for every child attending in 2017 due to changes in information required. Furthermore, all re-enrolments are due by the end of term at the very latest to confirm 2017 bookings; this includes including immunisation records. Please complete the forms in **full** and return by Friday 23rd September.

Our numbers have increased over the past few months. In accordance with our policies, it is imperative for the safety of their children for parents and caregivers to notify the Centre via phone call, email, using the Parent Communication Diary or in person. A \$10 non-notification fee will be charged to your account if we do not receive notice of your child not attending a session they are booked for. With the larger numbers this has caused concern as there are more calls to make, which can put other children in potential danger. Your co-operation will be gratefully appreciated.

Following discussion with the Principal and Deputy Principal we kindly ask all parents to remind their children, that if they are attending After School Care to go **straight** from their classroom to the agreed collection spot. The children are also required to sit down until we have accounted for each child and start our walk to the Centre. Please reinforce this with your child, as will the Educators and Teachers.
