





### The CAPER Program for Children Aged 6 to 14 years



Does your child experience any of the following?

- Has difficulty managing their emotions?
- Has unpredictable temper /anger outbursts?
- Becomes easily irritable or annoyed?
- Becomes argumentative for no good reason?
- Impulsively acts out (e.g. slams doors)

Researchers at the Centre for Emotional Health, at Macquarie University are conducting a new therapy program (the CAPER program) for children aged 6 to 14 years who are experiencing difficulties expressing or coping with their emotions. The therapy program is free of charge although a bond payment is required for eligible families which will be reimbursed at the end of the trial.

The program is being offered in 2017 to eligible families
