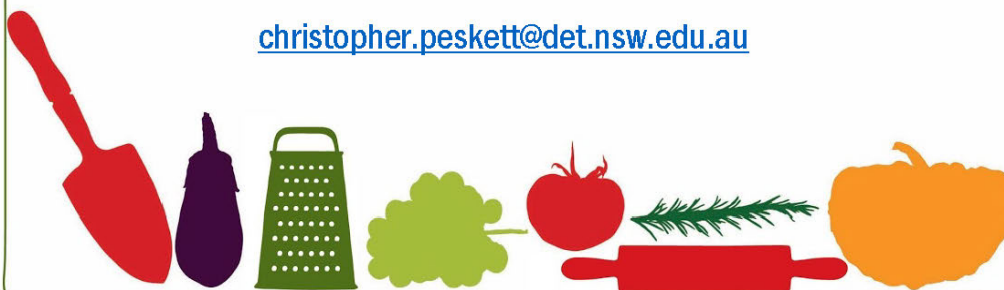

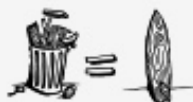

## **THE FOREST HIGH SCHOOL – GATS TEST, OPEN NIGHT & MEET THE PRINCIPAL DATES**

The Forest High School will be holding our **GATS (General Achievement) Test** on the following date:

**Saturday 10<sup>th</sup> March from 9.00am to 11.30am**

Testing will take place in the school hall. If you are unable to attend on this date a reserve session will also be held on **Monday 12<sup>th</sup> March from 4.00pm to 6.30pm**

Students wishing to be placed in our Gifted and Talented class for Year 7 2019 must first sit for this test. The Year 7 G&T class for Year 7 2019 will be determined after close examination of the test results and the students' NAPLAN results from Year 5. The cost of the test is \$40.00, payable on the day. Students are to bring a 2B or B pencil, an eraser and a ruler. No calculators or dictionaries can be used.

The test consists of three parts:

- Part 1 – Mathematics – 40 multiple-choice questions
- Part 2 – Reading and Language – 40 multiple-choice questions
- Part 3 – One writing task

Students are requested to arrive at The Forest High School **by 8.45am for a 9.00am start** or **by 3.45pm for a 4.00pm start**. They are also requested to bring a copy of their NAPLAN results on the day of the test. **If you would like your child to sit for this test please ring The Forest High School on 9451 5111 and register your name, your child's name, address & phone number. Please register by Friday 2nd March.**

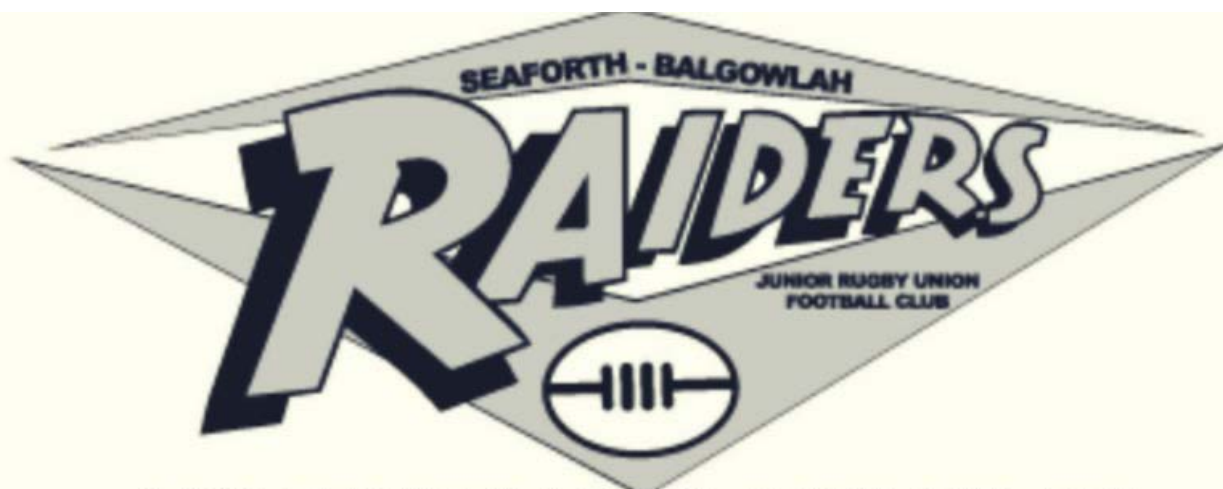
